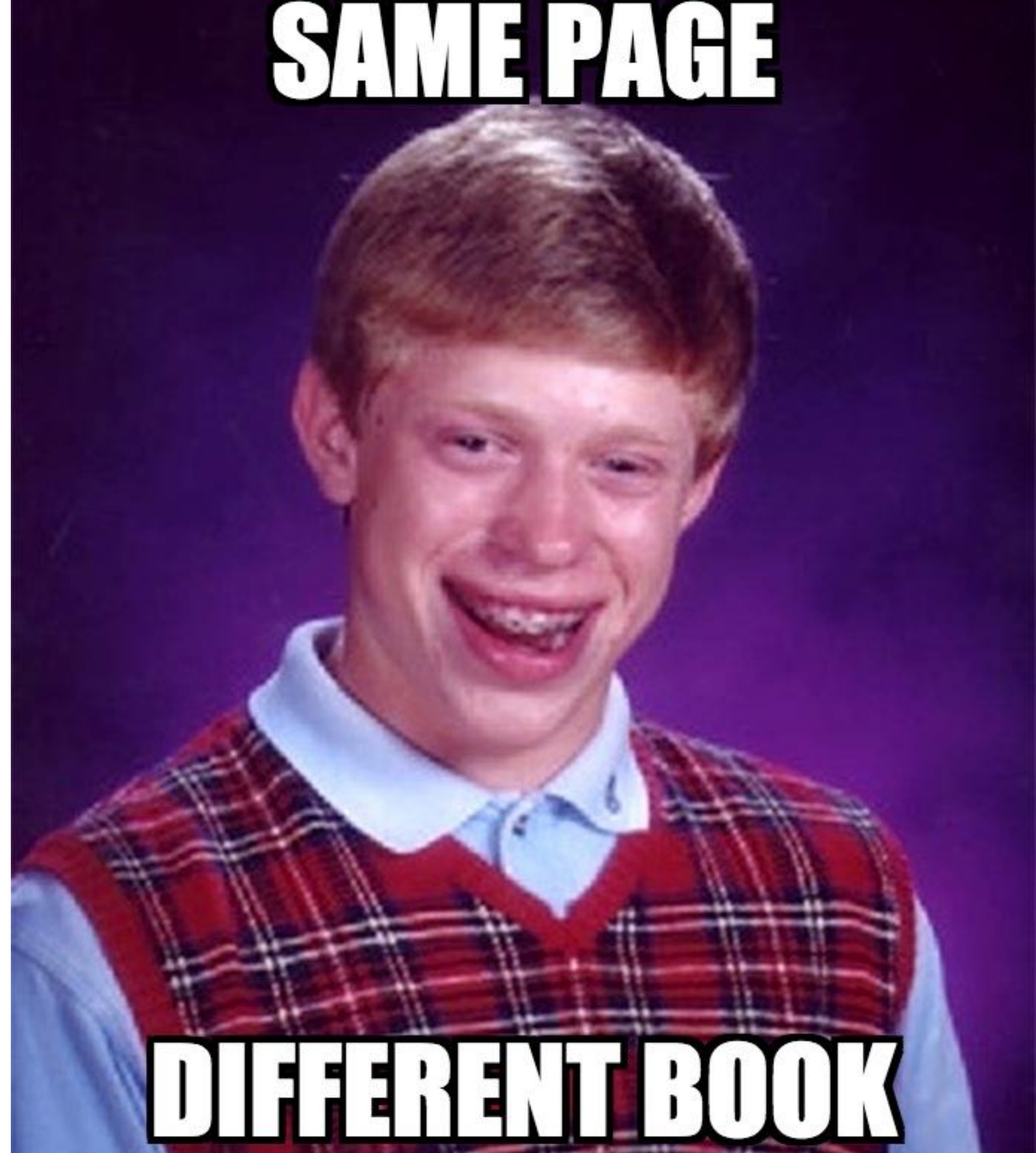

— Experts at Mitel

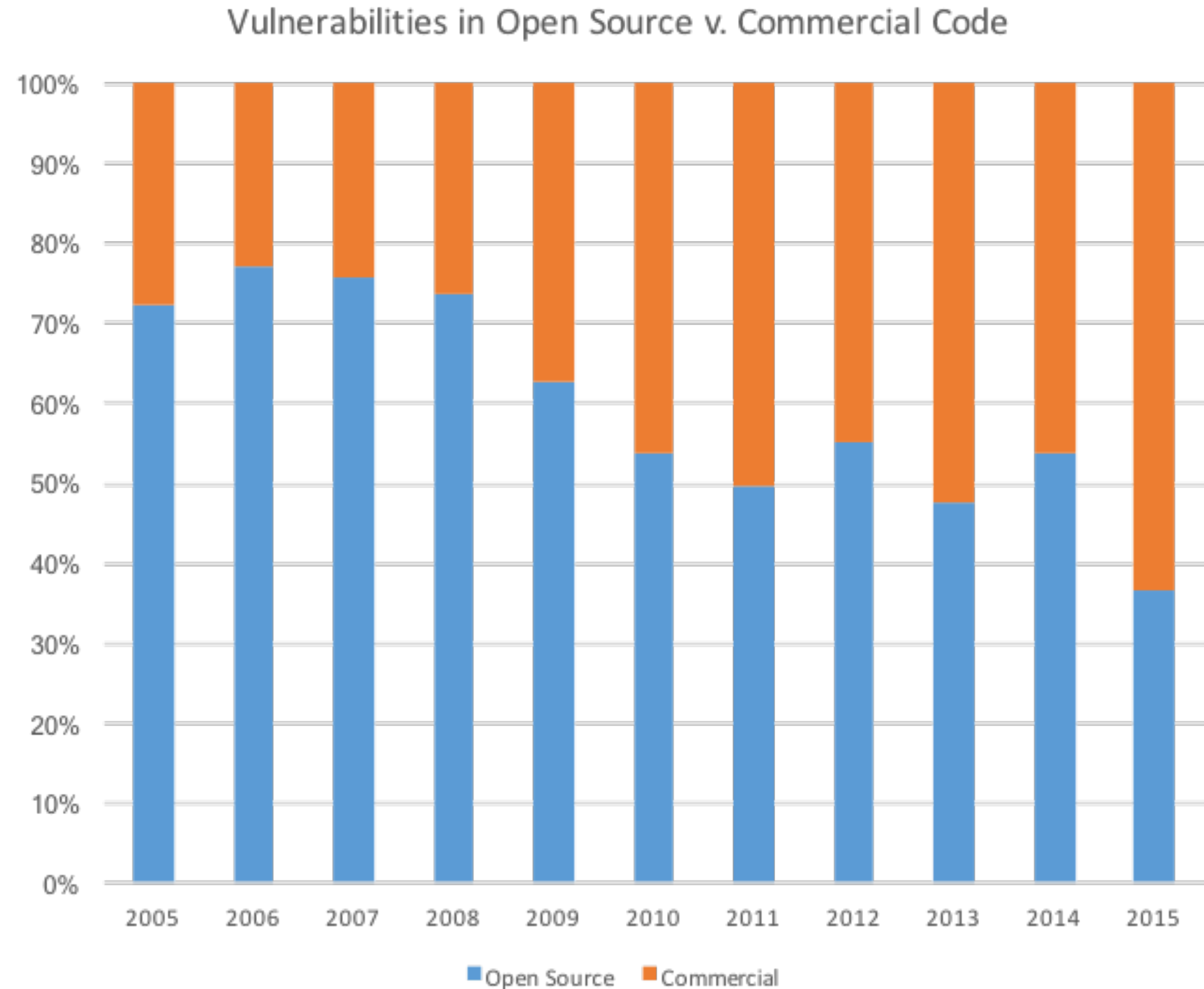
“Six Major Risks of Open Source Phone Systems”

We use thousands of open source projects to build scalable and reliable products.

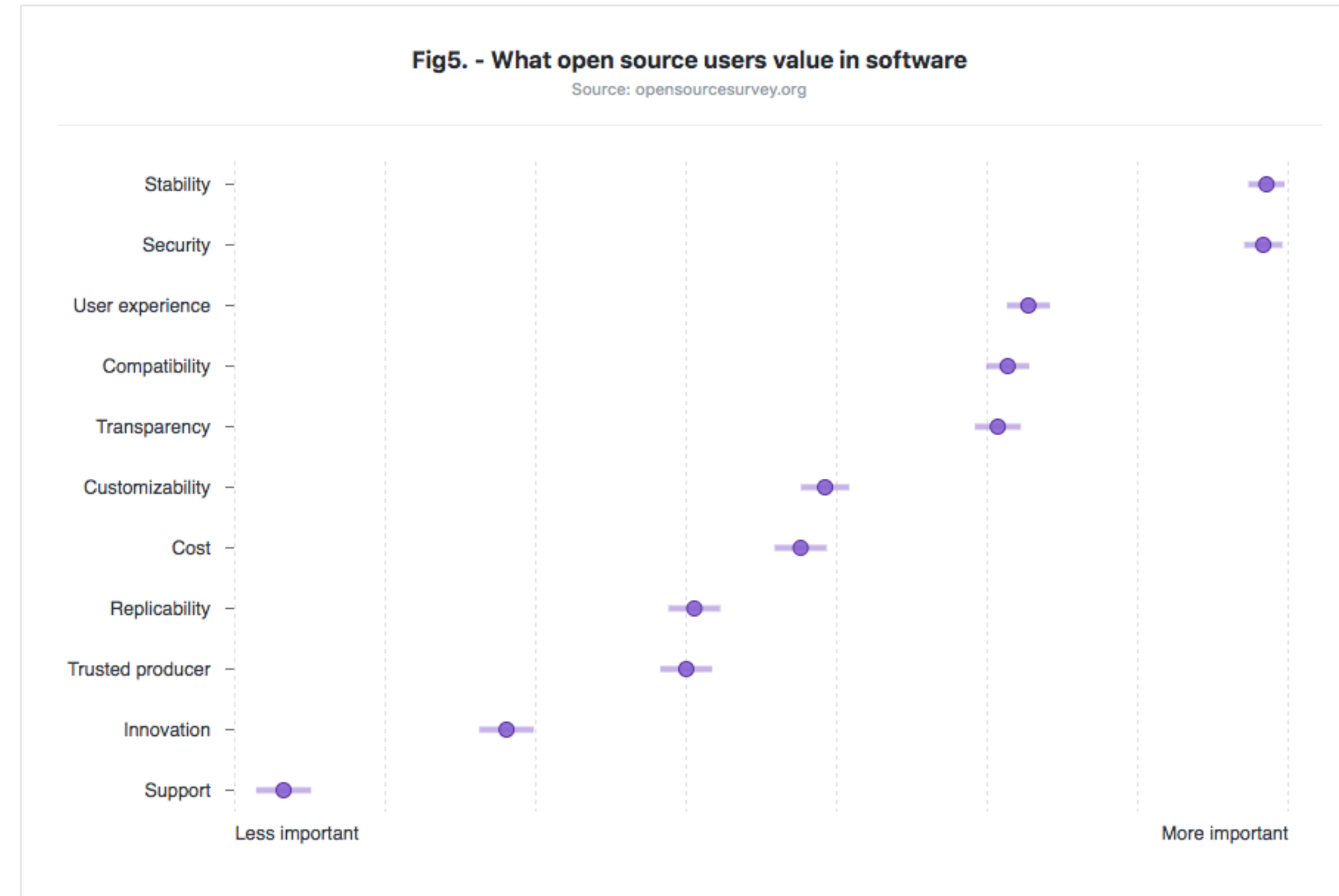

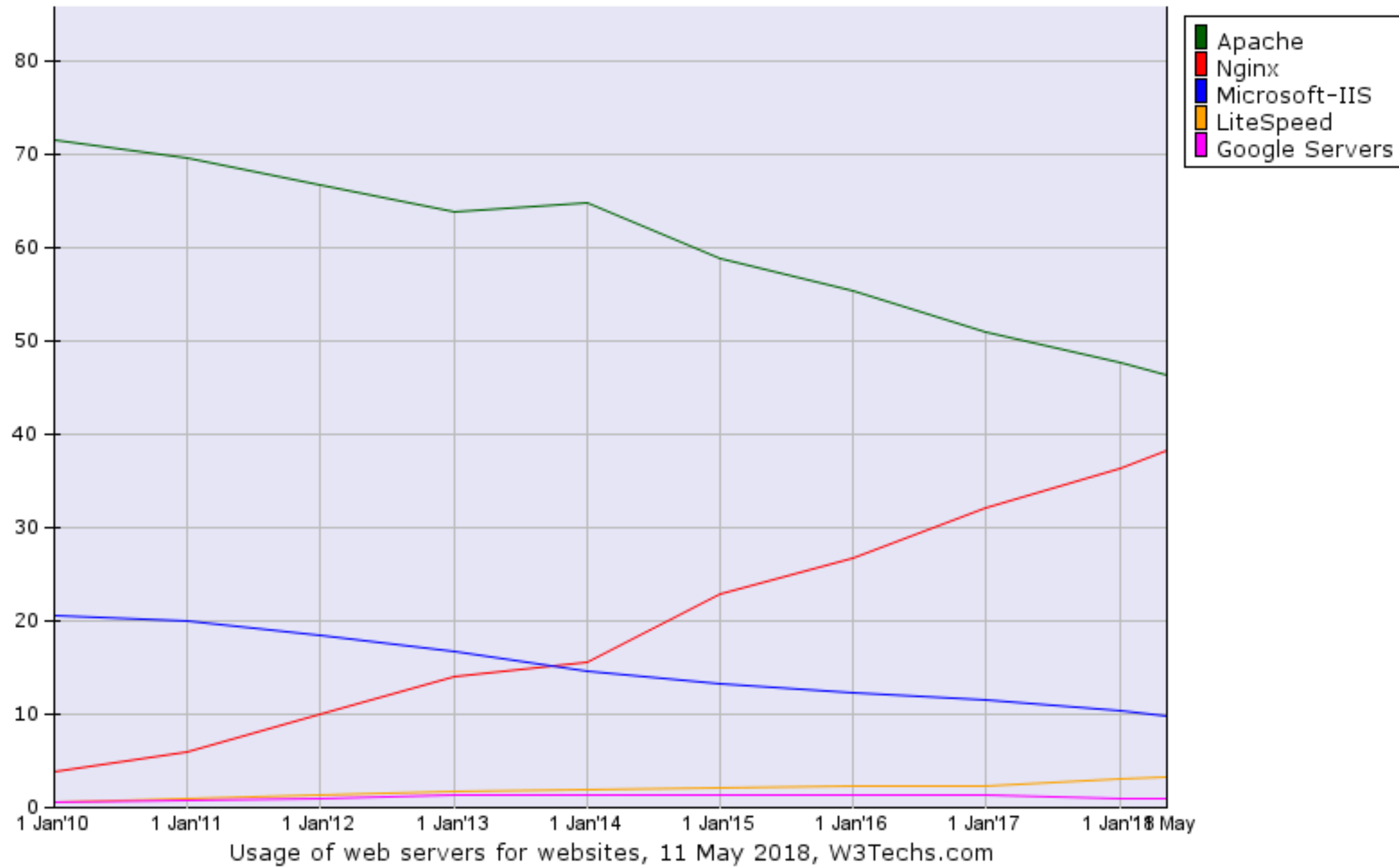
We consume and contribute tons of open source, so it's important for us to give back whenever possible.

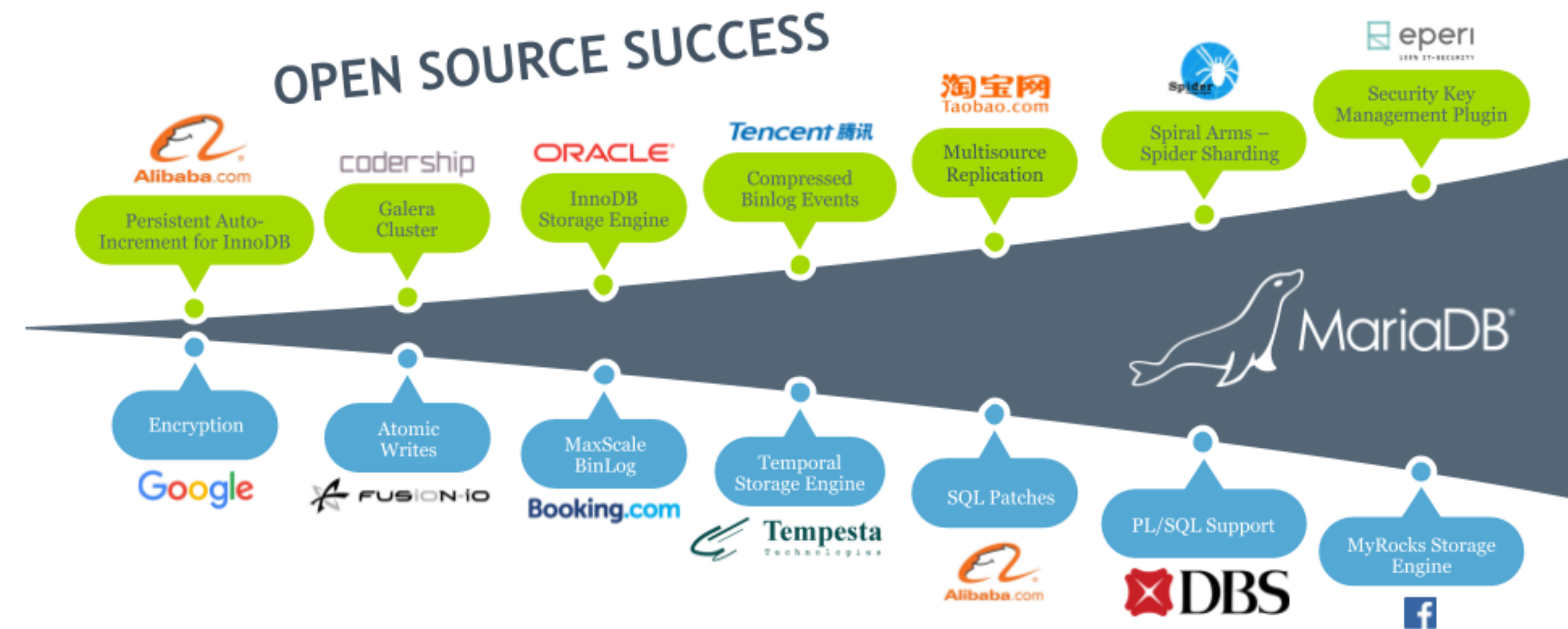

Open source is not Enterprise Grade

Scaling: MariaDB

- Wikipedia, Google, others use MariaDB
- ServiceNow runs MariaDB processing 25 billion queries per hour.
- English Wikipedia daily peak of ~50k queries/second



Open Source is...
Too Difficult to Use

MYTH

With an open source phone system, your IT team will need to have a more-than-advanced knowledge of how to install and configure all the necessary components to bring the system to life.

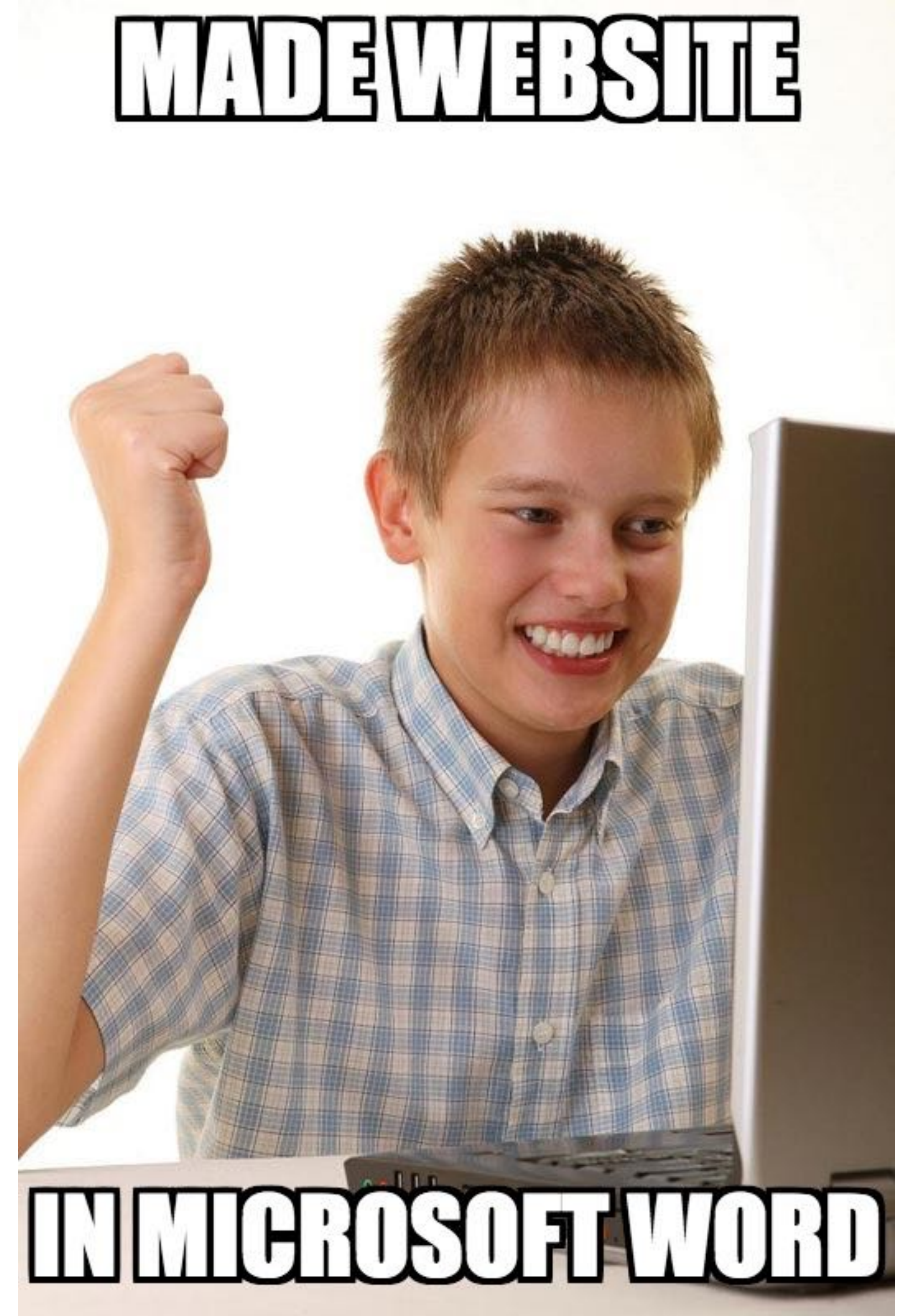

- Knowledge = Power
- Once you have concepts down, the software itself seems less difficult.
- Apache -> NGINX

Has No Support

MYTH

your reseller.

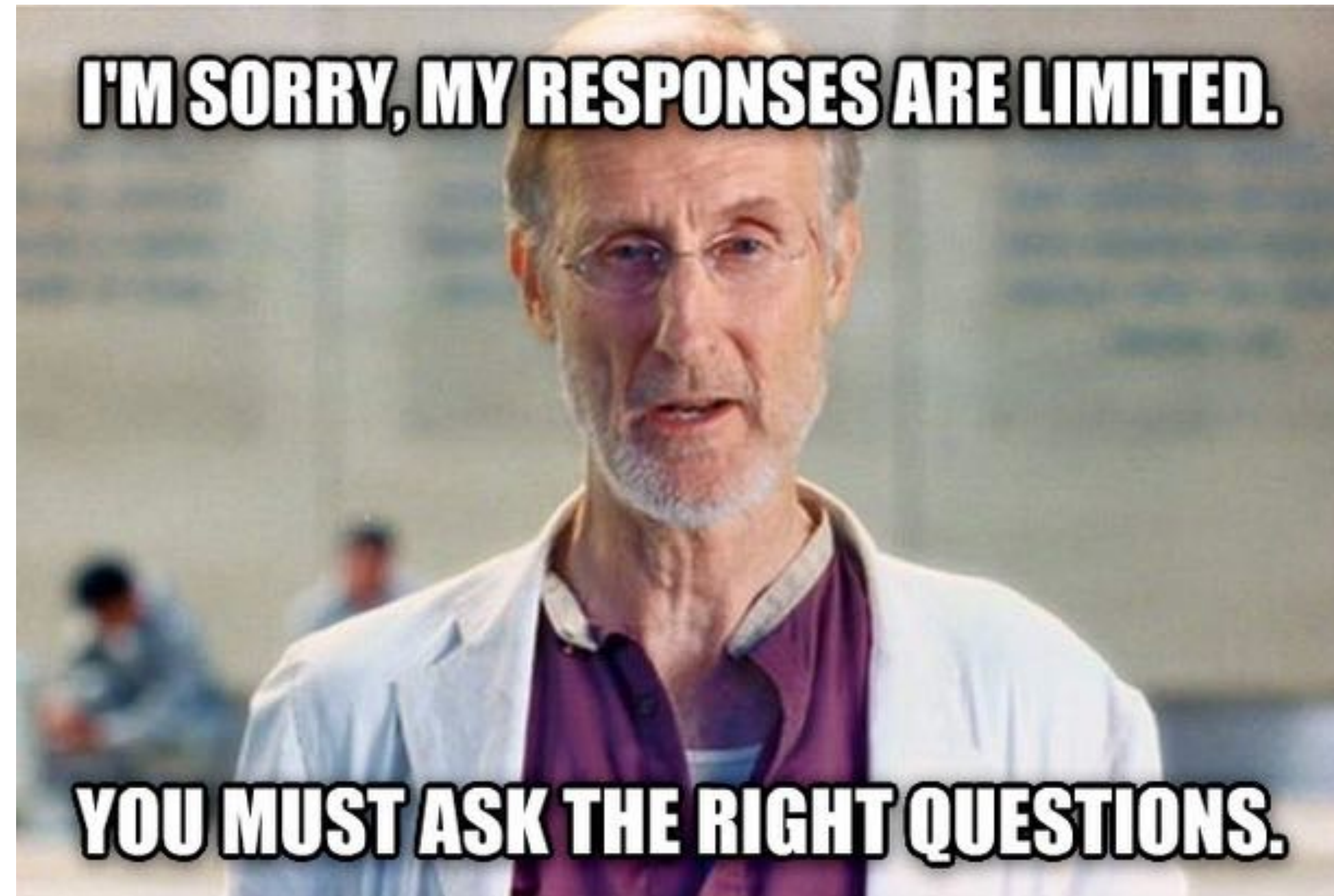
– Cisco, when asked “Does Cisco offer free support?”

Free Support or just support?

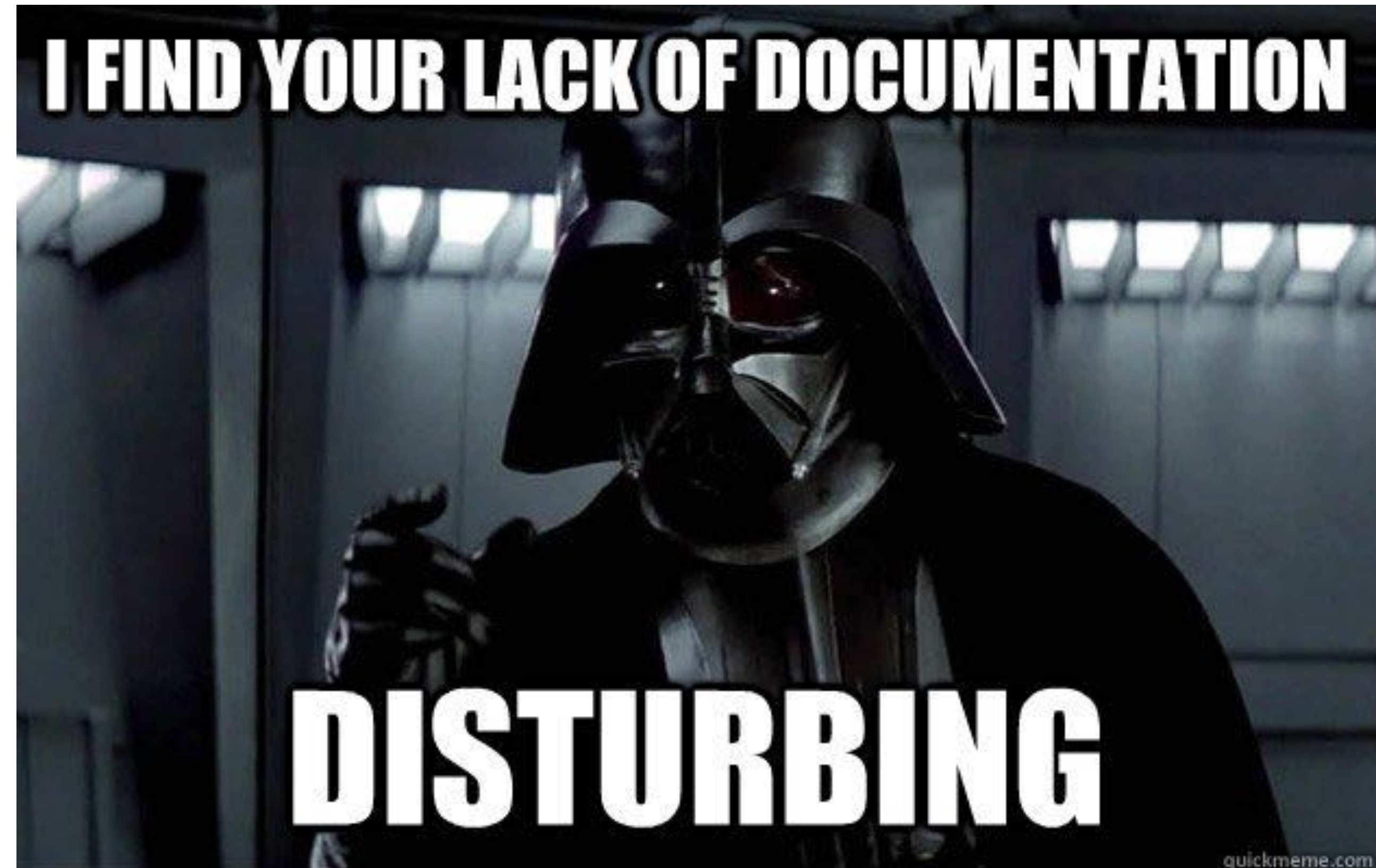
- Mailing lists, IRC, GitHub tickets, etc. are **very common** in open source.
- Proprietary support almost always has a cost.
- Paid support is also available for open source software. *ahem*



This being said...

We can do better...

- There is always room for better documentation.
- Everyone in this room can help with documentation.
- Everyone in this room **NEEDS** to help with documentation.



How do you counter these myths?

Big Money = Dirty Tricks

Open Source is a threat to licensing revenue



Kamailio downloads are decreasing rapidly, so the project won't be around much longer

– Client report deciding between Kamailio and Cisco

2017 Revenue

- Cisco: 48 billion USD
- IBM: 79 billion USD
- Oracle: 38 billion USD
- Microsoft: 90 billion USD
- Avaya: 3 billion USD
- Mitel: 1 billion USD



That's great...

but is open source a *safe* solution?

FUD

Fear, Uncertainty and Doubt

FUD

- Disinformation strategy
- Popular in sales, PR, talk radio, etc.
- Influence perception
- Negative, False information
- Appeal to Fear
- Common in software and hardware
