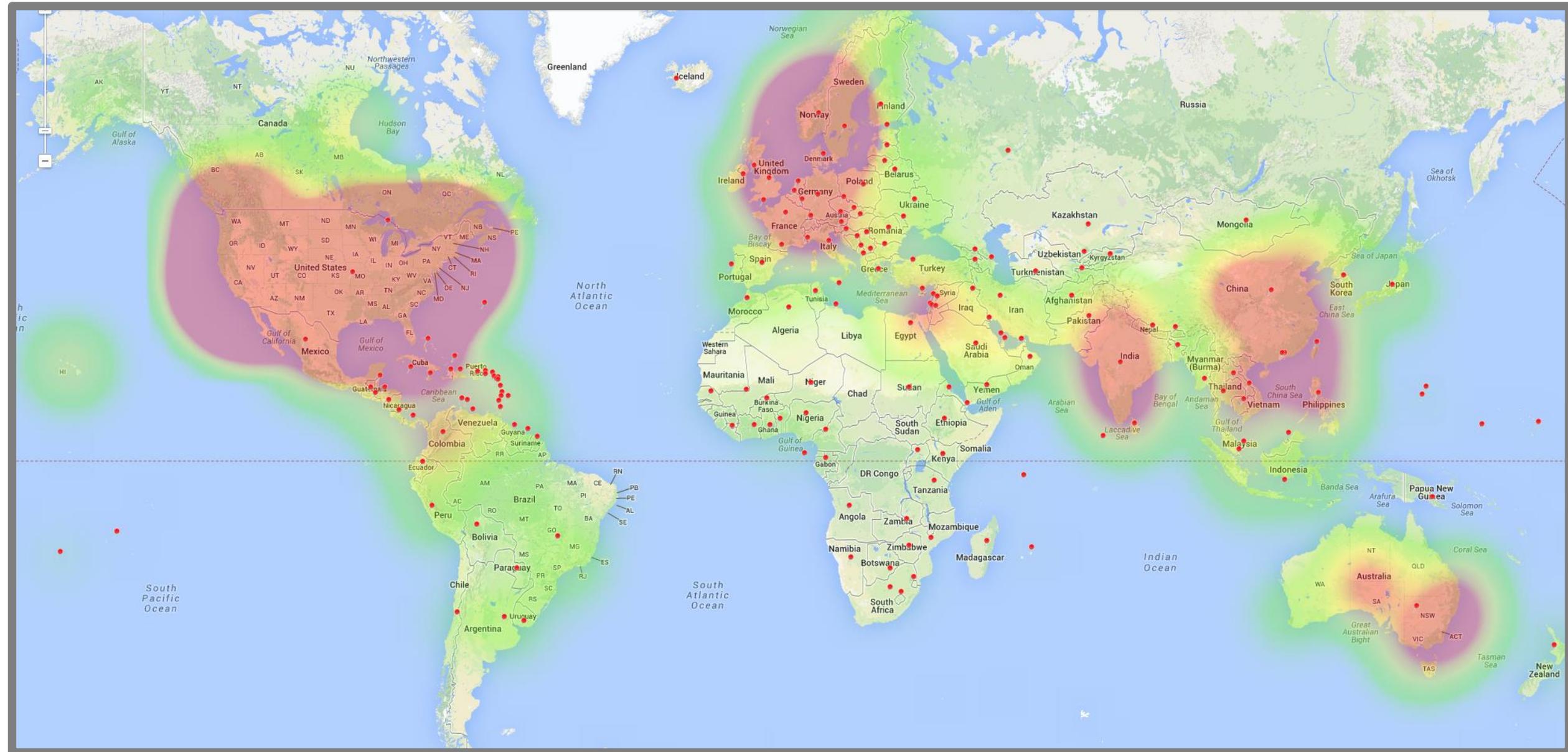

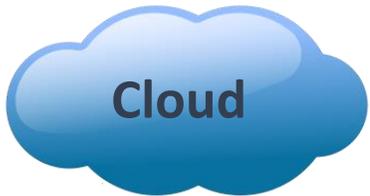

LTE Gateway – Models Built-in Router

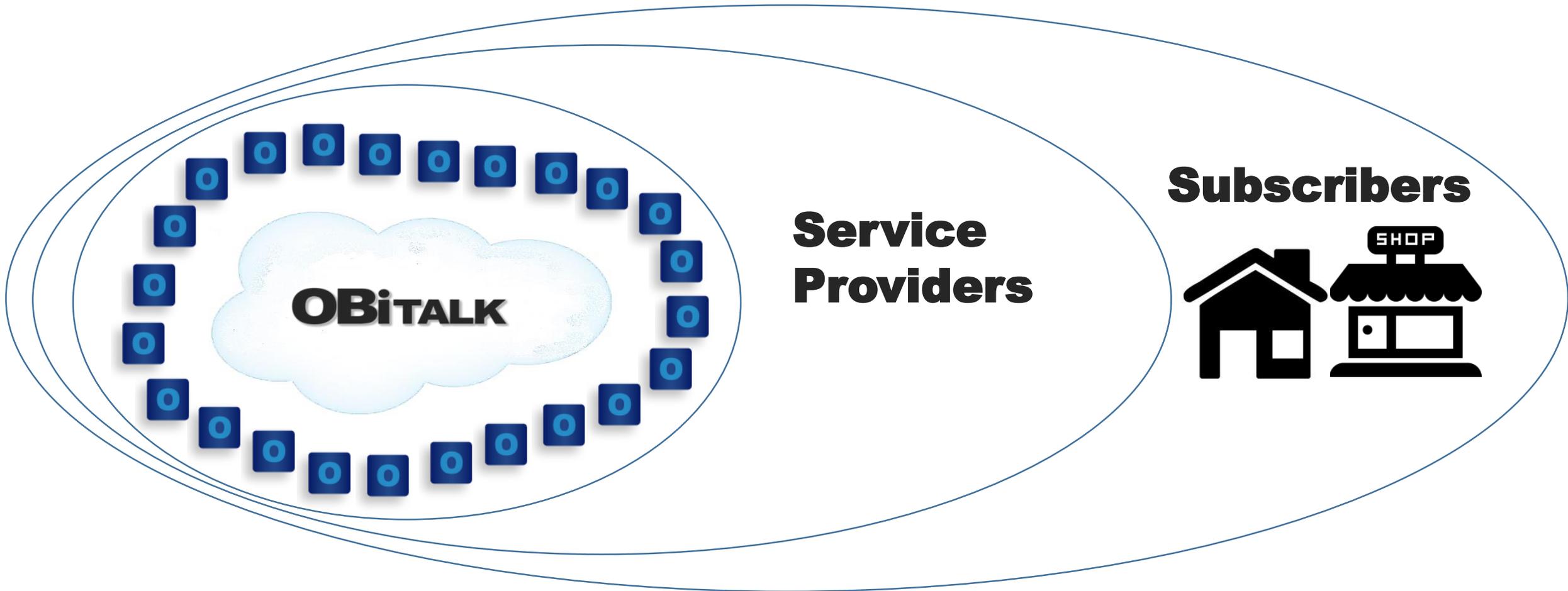
The OBi works with LTE USB Dongles to provide instant Internet to voice services.

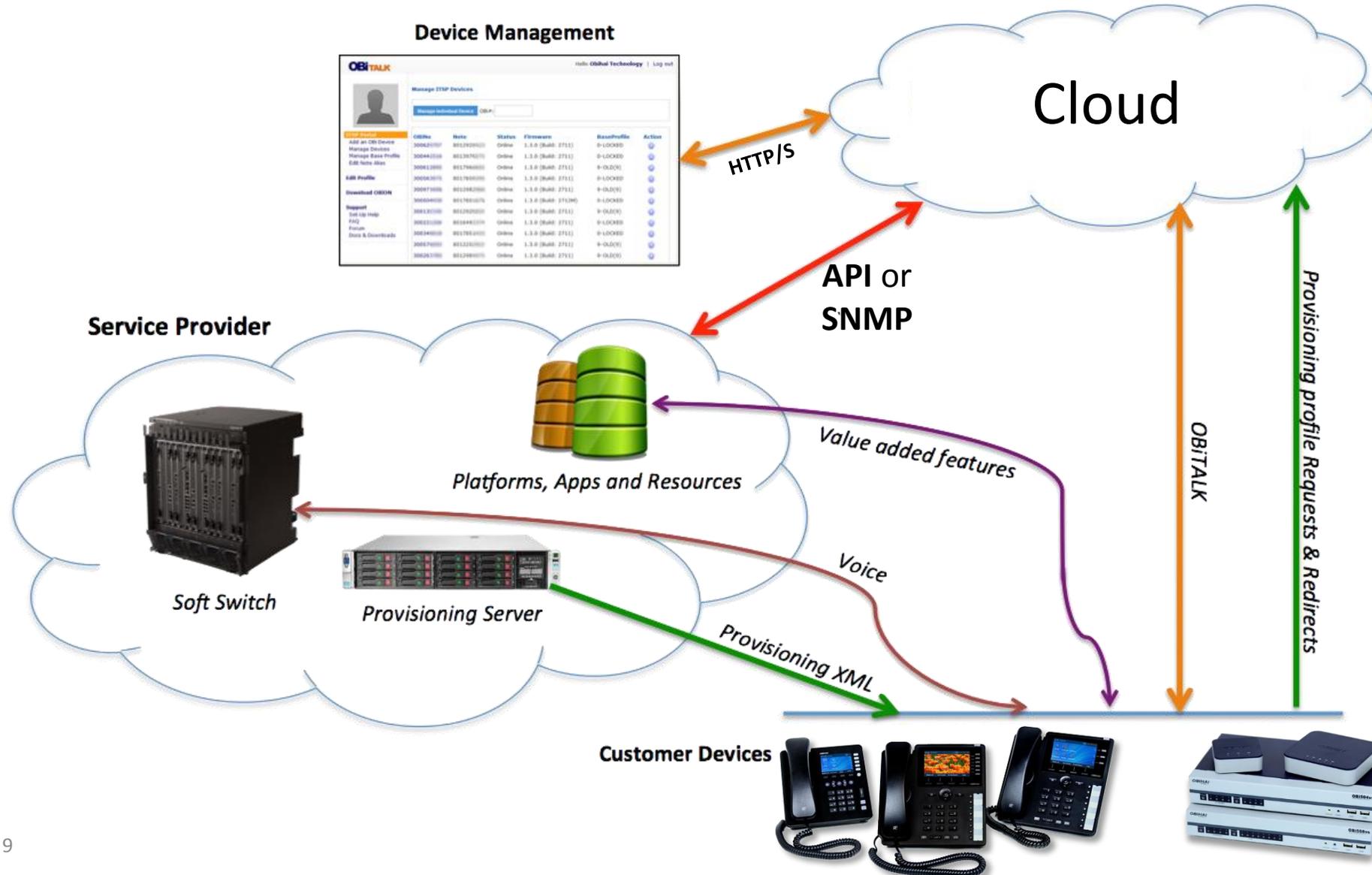

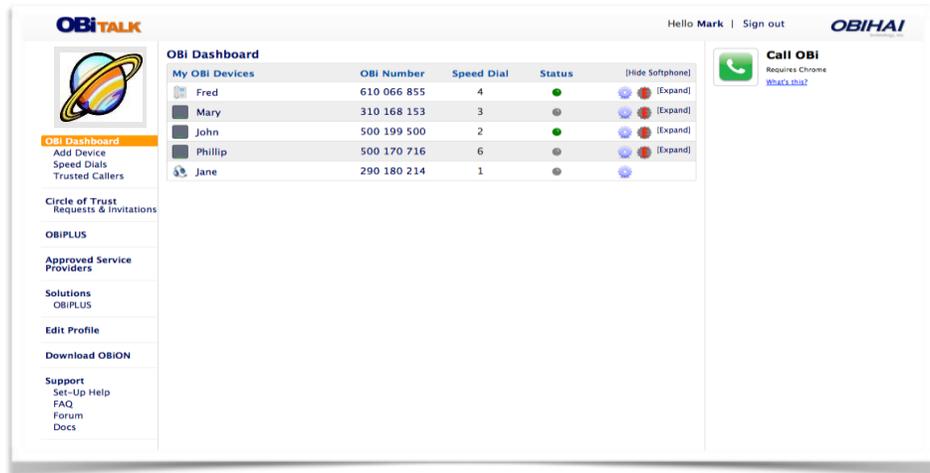

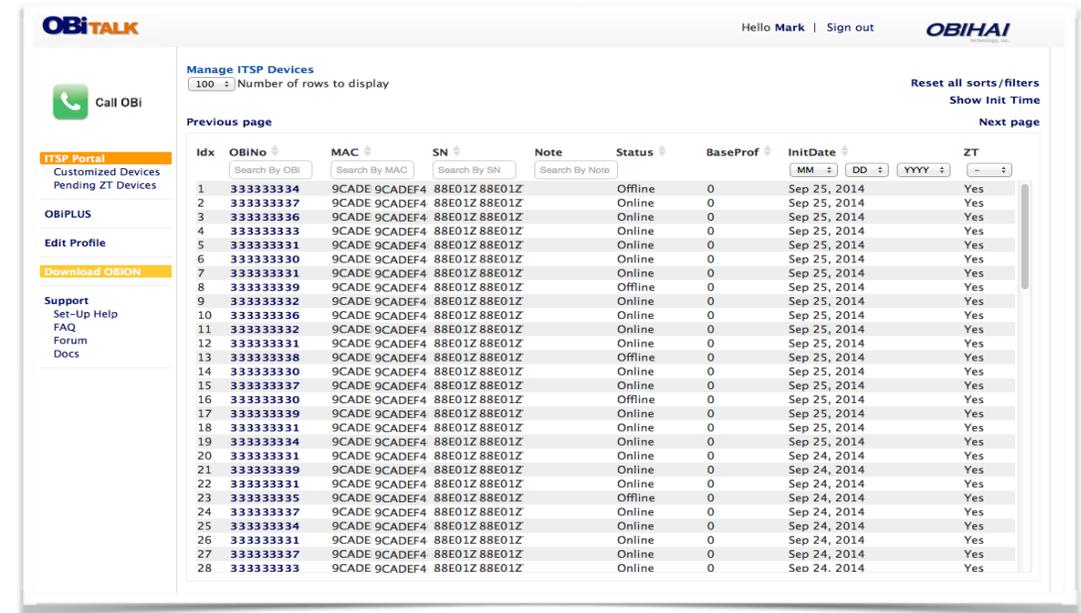

Web Portal Management



Consumer Portal:
Portal for end users allows easy device setup and configuration



Service Provider Portal:
Portal for service providers allows for advanced configuration and device management

Cloud Management Functionality

Service Activation AIP / Generic Device Configuration Manipulation

- ASP – Approved Service Provider
- SAC – Service Activation Code

Reporting Stats:

- RTCP-XR via API or SNMP
- Alternative to SIP PUBLISH
- Call Quality, Uptime, Registration Anomalies (Trying/Failing/Retrying)
- Grouping / Trend Analysis

Device Troubleshooting

- Additional ‘View’ to Coincide with Call Quality and Uptime Stats Reporting

P2P and Other “Connecting” Services - Twilio Example

- SIP to Cloud to Device
- Very Extensible – Low Cost, E.g. Sensors, Alarms, Bluetooth etc.

Protocols, Codecs & Services

WebRTC or SIP or XMPP or ...
